### Priority 2010 Strategic Goals

- 1) Continue to work Toward Achieving Financial Stability
  - a) Minimize rate creep
  - b) Stabilize debt and financial needs for next 5 – 10 years
- 2) Acquire new systems/enterprises where it strengthens the PUD's finances
  - a) Work toward a goal of 5,000 total customers by the end of 2012 through acquisition and satellite management of systems with good value
  - b) Continue to aggressively market SMA/O&M acquisition – existing systems
  - c) Strive for a major share of Thurston County's future growth as the County's primary public water utility
  - d) Continued marketing and communication about the PUD (website, newsletters)
  - e) Focus on opportunities in the rural portions of Thurston County
  - f) Prepare for the retirement of critical staff through cross-training and identification of key skills for new staff
  - g) Explore new lines of business as opportunities arise
- 3) Stabilize and Develop the PUD
  - a) Continue to identify and improve key infrastructure needs
  - b) Continue to review, revise, update and improve the PUD's processes, policies & procedures
  - c) Continue to develop a Multi-year Capital Improvement Plan/Asset Planning Model
  - d) Continue Development of a Strategic Budget Model
  - e) If finances permit, bring forward a program for Commissioners to consider which will assist low income PUD customers who have trouble with their bills
- 4) Water System Plan – Implement the Plan to Complete Part B's (small system management program plans)
- 5) Develop Partnerships region-wide by continuing to:
  - a) Continue to pursue an MOA with County
  - b) Pursue Grant Opportunities for County-wide Planning
  - c) Encourage more focus on Water Planning within TRPC
  - d) Nurture relationships with Olympia, Tumwater, Lacey, and Yelm and the Tribes
- 6) Pursue opportunities for sustainability and a reduced carbon footprint
