Commissioners Corner

In September 2016, the Commissioners of PUD No. 1 of Thurston County held a series of Public Hearings to provide our customers and members of the public the opportunity to comment on proposed options for the 2017 Budget and Rates. At the public meeting of September 27, 2016, the Commis-

sioners voted to adopt the 2017 Budget with rates to go into effect January 2017 resulting in an average 3.95% increase for all customers. The increase has been applied to both the base rate and to all usage blocks equally. Customers using 1,000 cubic feet of water can expect to see an increase of \$2.32 monthly. In addition, the Commissioners adopted a new increase to the capital surcharge implemented to fund the improvements and replacements identified in the District's Asset Management Plan. The 2017 Capital Surcharge will be in addition to your regular water charges and will be \$4.80 per month per equivalent residential unit, an increase of \$1.90 over 2016.
